The convergence of Edge Computing and the Internet of Things (IoT) enabled real-time data processing and widespread adoption. "The growth of the general market has slowed and stagnated throughout 2023 as companies and businesses come to terms with inflation and the higher cost of living. However, this brings faster-changing customer demands, and product managers must continually adapt to ever-changing trends. There will be greater demand for product talent as product-led growth becomes more important. There is a higher demand for product managers who can lead cross-functional teams to deliver successful products. The role of a Product Manager is getting more complicated, with an emerging need for different roles and hierarchies within the product team. On top of this, product leaders need more talent to build out their function beneath them to keep up with these demands, leading to higher competition and becoming one of the most sought-after technology jobs."

"In 2022, Germany experienced an unprecedented two-year salary increase, with a particular focus on Berlin. The city, once among the lowest-paid in the Technology sector due to its affordability, now boasts the highest salaries. Senior software engineers saw their average base salary rise from 65,000-70,000€ pre-pandemic to around 80,000-85,000€ within two years.

This salary surge may be attributed to significant investments by venture capitalists, leading to record-breaking funding rounds. Consequently, more companies achieved Unicorn status or reached a 1 billion euro valuation within a year of establishment.

Companies in Berlin also offered RSUs or VSOPs in addition to base salaries to secure top talent, setting them apart from other German cities. The absence of similar VC funding and major US companies in these cities may explain the disparity in salary growth. US companies typically offer high base salaries, often supplemented with stock options, making them tough competitors for employers throughout Germany, unable to match the allure for top talent from Berlin."

"In the era of persistent cyber threats, Germany's recruitment landscape fiercely vies for top cyber security talent. Organisations aggressively seek professionals with advanced threat detection, incident response, and risk mitigation expertise. Additionally, there is a growing emphasis on individuals proficient in securing cloud environments, managing data privacy regulations, and implementing robust security architectures. Companies are offering competitive compensation packages, career growth opportunities, and investing in continuous training programs to attract and retain such talent. As Germany strengthens its cyber resilience, the demand for skilled cyber security experts remains high, making it an exciting time for professionals seeking to make a meaningful impact in protecting digital assets."

Cost optimisation roles are emerging as organisations address Cloud implementation challenges. Microsoft's Azure is dominating the Cloud space, outperforming AWS and G-Cloud. Given the significant scale and rapid growth of the Cloud sector, the demand for talent will continue to grow, as will the number of candidates entering the workforce. However, a shortage of top-quality candidates may result in rising salary expectations for skilled professionals in the Cloud domain. Overall, the Cloud industry in Germany is set to witness further expansion and evolution, making it a crucial area for businesses and job seekers."

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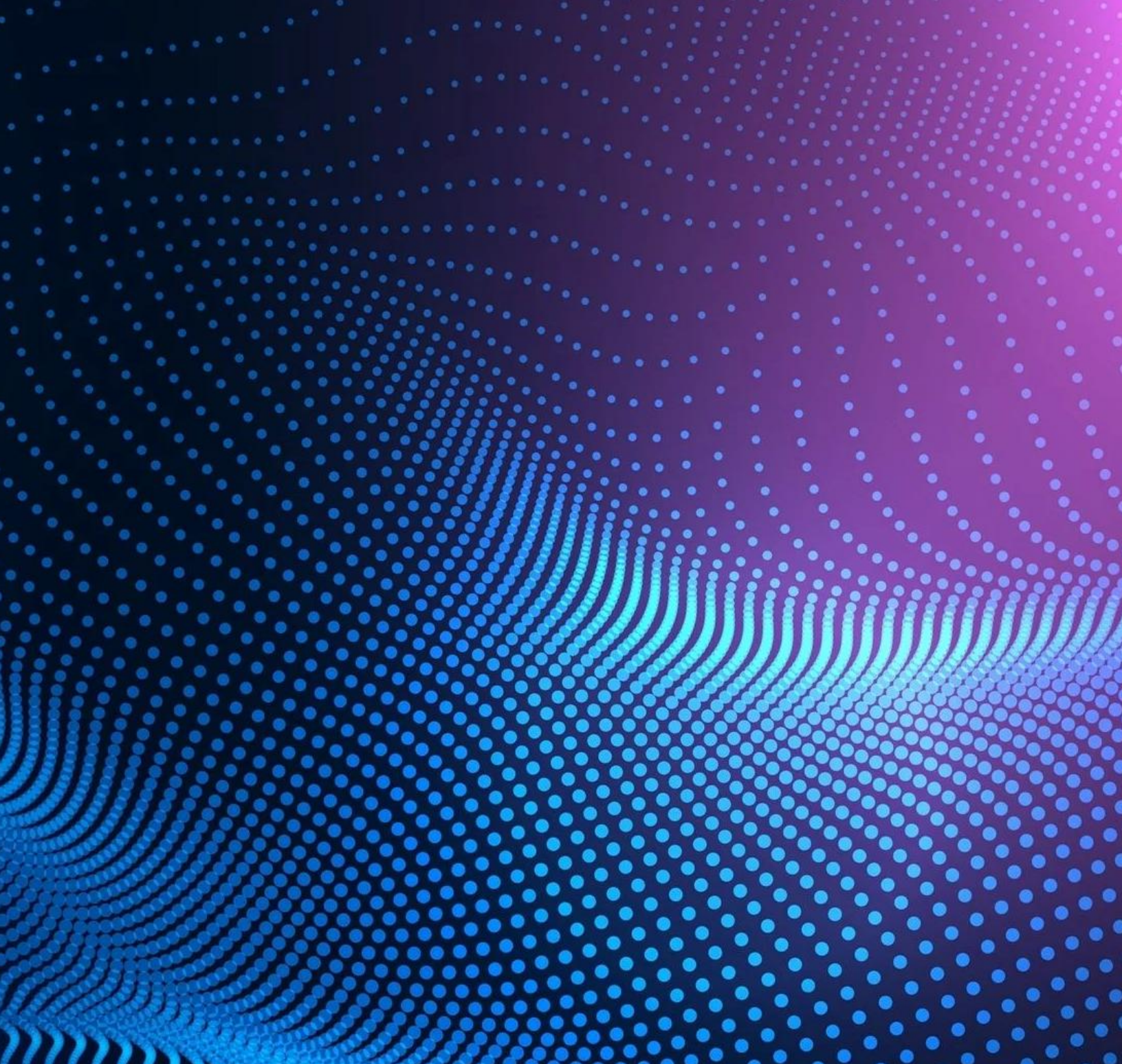
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
