About the role

Choosing to work as a PIP Functional Assessor for Medacs Healthcare is a diverse and rewarding profession.

As a part of our team, you will use your skills as a healthcare professional to play a vital role in the functional and disability assessment process – a service that makes a difference to the lives of millions of people throughout the UK.

In this role, you will carry out assessments either in-person or virtually for those making a claim for the Personal Independent Payment (PIP) benefit or being referred through the Government's Health Advisory Assessment Services (HAAS).

The conditions and impairments of those making a claim are often complex, so for you it is a great opportunity to broaden your clinical experience and knowledge.

Using your clinical knowledge and experience, you will review information provided by the individual or their representative, alongside medical evidence available.

Your role as a PIP Functional Assessor is to gather further information about their medical conditions, in order to make an assessment which you then use to provide a personalised report.

Your reports should be a true reflection of the individual's functional ability and meet the standards set out by the Department of Work and Pensions,

within the PIP Assessment Guide. This will enable the Department of Work and Pensions to make an informed decision on their claim.

Recruitment Process

After a successful pre-screen, you will be asked to complete a typing test followed by an online clinical scenario. This will be reviewed by our clinical team and if successful, we will schedule an interview.

Your interview will include questions about your experience and what you could bring to the role. This will give you an in-depth insight into what the role involves.

If successful, you will be formally offered a role with a start date and once you have accepted the role and are fully compliant, you will begin the training process.


Training and Support:
